Foster & Kinship Care Chaplain for Tasmania

Fostering Hope and Anglican Health and Welfare (AH&W) are excited to announce a new chaplain role – a chaplain dedicated to foster and kinship carers in Tasmania. The fostering journey is unique to any other role and full of emotional ups and downs. The Chaplain will seek to be an empathetic listening ear for carers as they journey new placements, placement breakdown, reunifications, behaviour challenges, and all the joys of being a foster/kinship carer.

The Chaplain will see to be an empathetic listener to a carer and meet the emotional and spiritual needs for carers. The Chaplain will offer high quality pastoral care to foster and kinship carers.

AH&W have provided chaplaincy services in Tasmania for decades with chaplains placed at the Royal Hobart Hospital, Risdon Prison, and in response to emergency situations. Fostering Hope works in the Tasmanian community to raise awareness about the need for more foster homes amongst the Christian community, recruit and support Christian carers. This partnership brings together two complimentary organisations to provide a chaplain for all foster and kinship carers in Tasmania.


There are still a few places available in the Hobart course.
